- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization

• 60 logged dives

### Assistant Instructor

### **Prerequisites**

- Padi Divemaster certifications or qualifying certification from another training organization
- 18 years old
- Diving physical (RSTC medical release signed by a doctor within past 12 months)
- Certified as a diver for 6 months
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving
- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization
- If not a Padi Divemaster must successfully complete a diver rescue skills assessment

## Open Water Scuba Instructor

### **Prerequisites**

- Padi Assistant Instructor or as a current Instructor in good standing with another recreational diver training organization for at least 6 months
- 18 years old
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving
- Diving physical (RSTC medical release signed by a doctor within past 12 months)
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving
- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization
